PARTICIPATION is the cruising word for July. Just by joining SOS you are participating in one of the most fun, relaxing, and exhilarating sports there is!

Each boat you are on will expect you to participate in the sailing of the boat: pulling lines, raising sails, securing fenders, steering, maybe drop an anchor. If you are unable to meaningfully participate, ask the skipper to help you with your skills (see June's word of the month!). Your participation in sailing doesn't end when the boat is docked—you will need to help clean up the boat and take gear off. It's still not over! Fill out that **Survey Monkey** that you will get in your email; it helps us evaluate parties, anchorages, sailing distances, etc.

SOS relies on volunteers for all of its activities. You can participate in shaping the Club and enhancing your own enjoyment by volunteering for a committee or to help out. The **Cruising C ommittee** has opportunities for folks who want to see how a coordination is done (how DID I get on that boat?!), or help out with spreadsheets to document the sails. The **Social C ommittee** often needs people to help out with parties—registration, bartending, set up, etc. Mary Ellen Murphy (chair) would welcome your help. The **Education Committee** has multiple opportunities available: host or present a Fireside Chat, attend one; go to a seminar; help out with Spring Training.

If you missed Anniversary Party and/or the Cambridge sail, there are more opportunities in July and early August—sign up early, sign up often for **Day Sails** on July 14 and 18, and **Weekend Cruises** on July 21-22 (First Mates Cruise with Lollipop Cruise) and Aug. 4-5 (Seafood Feast).

Unofficial notes June 7, 2018 Board Meeting

Official June minutes will be posted on the SOS web site when approved in July by the Board of Directors.

Commodore: This is the start of transitioning to new board with the enactment of the Nominating Committee, We need to establish a transition/off site meeting with committee chairs to provide background on their respective jobs and responsibilities.

Vice Commodore: Led discussion on revisions to policy about SOS documents to be retained or destroyed.

Treasurer: Present current financial statements.

Bareboat: May gathering was a great success. 9 of the 12 skippers attended as did approximately 20 crew members. A proposal on the Belize Trip has been sent to the board. Lorraine Fassett, who has quite a bit of experience in Sweden, has kindly offered to assist Deb Kaufmann in coordinating a Sweden event.

Brunches: Have been in contact with Teresa Scofield, Brunch Mentor and Mary Ellen Murphy, Social Committee to discuss event dates so can begin to plan Brunches and speakers. I recommend continuing to use the DoubleTree Hotel for Brunches because they have all of the needed amenities required for our events.

Cruising: The weather continues to impact participation in sails, resulting in cancellations and refunds. Although some 17 boats signed up for DNR, only 5 sailed due to heavy rain. Many of those who cancelled sailing did drive in for the party. Memorial Day weekend saw 12-14 boats; a couple of those boats returned home after the first night due to forecast of rain. The weather precluded raft building, and pods were easily formed.

Database: I have investigated the attempted email scam and it appears the fraud is a disguised Gmail address to make it look as if it were from the commodore. All the information used is contained in the Whisker Pole, which is available to the public. My conclusion there was not a breach of MemberClicks. Some but not all blasts are being delivered without their accompanying graphics. From what I have been able to determine, the blasts are being composed and sent properly. Believe the issue has something to do with the apps or software on the receiving end. Will investigate further.

Education: No Report.

Membership: 500 directories were printed, 265 were mailed and have 135 on reserve. The cost \$3,462.63. We have had 14 new members this month. We plan to have some "What's the Scoop" gathering in the fall.

First Mates: First Mate Candidate, Bill Knapp, has completed his requirements and we welcome him into the First Mate family. Article for the July Whisker Pole announcing Bill's accomplishment has been submitted. The First Mate Meeting/Potluck is on schedule for June 16th. Details for the July 21-22, First Mate sail, are moving along.

Newsletter: The June 20-page Whisker Pole was mailed to 94 members and 33 Happy Hour coordinators and were printed at a cost of \$ 531.88 which equates to \$4.18 per copy.

Public Relations: No report

Safety: I want to work on getting our skippers to get their boats checked by the USCG Aux or America's Boating Club examiners.

Skippers' Advisory: Dave Henkin reports that none of the individuals that are new or returning have turned into active skippers on approved boats yet. The following issues have been raised and are being worked on: (1) crew training deficiencies identified, (2) skipper training for rafting operations, (3) skippers need to contact offered crew ASAP (24 hours) so all can be prepared for a cruise.

Social: Planning for both DNR Party and Anniversary Party are well underway. Requested the Board allocated additional funds to make the 40th Anniversary extra special.

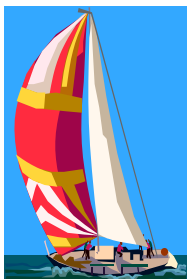

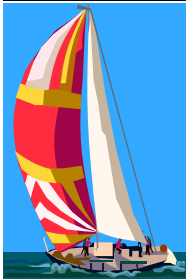

Haven Harbour South (formerly named Sailing Emporium): 21144 Green Ln, Rock Hall, MD havenharbour.com

From the South - East over the Chesapeake Bay Bridge to Rt. 301. Take Rt. 213 north to Chestertown. Proceed through Chestertown- turn left at Rt. 291 (Morgnec Rd) go to end, turn right onto Rt. 20 to Rock Hall (12 miles). Turn left at the blinking light (Main St.). Go through town of Rock Hall. Turn right onto Green Lane. Continue to the Sailing Emporium entrance on your right.

From the North - Interstate 95 to Rt. 896 S to Rt. 896/301 Take 301 (past Middletown, DE) to exit right onto Rt. 290 to Galena. Go through light at Galena. Now on Rt. 213. Continue to Chestertown. Turn right on Rt. 291. Go to the end; turn right on Rt. 20, to Rock Hall. Continue as above.



Galesville Memorial Hall; 952 Main Street; Galesville, MD From Annapolis:

Take MD Rt 2 South to MD Rt 255 East (left) to Galesville. Cross MD Rt 468. Continue on Rt. 255, which becomes Main Street. Just after the post office and before the firehouse, the hall is on the left. **From Route 50:** Take Exit 16, MD Rt 424 to Davidsonville. Continue past Davidsonville to MD Rt 2 South (right) then to MD Rt 255 East (left) to Galesville. Cross MD Rt 468. Continue on Rt. 255, which becomes Main Street. Just after the post office and before the firehouse, the hall is on the left.

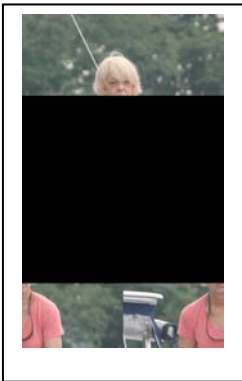

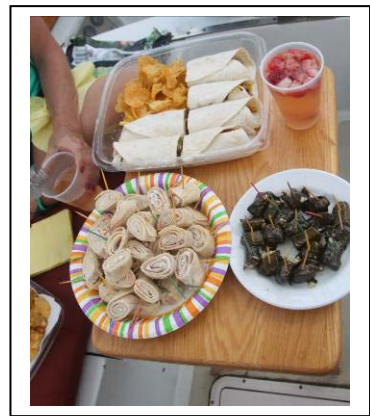
